All qualifying graduating high school students may receive one scholarship from AHEPA Little Fort Chapter 218. Completed applications will be evaluated by the Scholarship Award Committee, which was nominated or appointed by the President of AHEPA Chapter 218 and approved by Chapter 218 members.

BASIC REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

1. Academic Standing

To be considered for a scholarship the graduating high school applicant must:

- Have maintained legal residence in Lake County, IL for at least one year before applying.
- Be graduating from high school in 2024.
- Have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.0 through the first half of the senior year of high school.
- Provide letters of recommendation on official stationery sent directly from a clergy member, teacher, or counselor to the Scholarship Committee Chairman.
- Provide an official transcript of high school grades sent directly from the high school office of administration to the Scholarship Committee Chairman.
- Graduating high school seniors must send or present Page 3 of this application to their High School Administrator for completion and mailing no later than March 31, 2024.

2. Hellenic Connection:

Eligible applicants must have at least one of the following:

- Current membership in good standing in AHEPA Chapter 218, District 13 for at least one full year before submission of the application.
- Parent or grandparent who is a member in good standing in AHEPA Chapter 218, District 13 for at least one full year before submission of the application.
- Sponsorship by a member in good standing in AHEPA Chapter 218, District 13 for at least one full year before submission of the application.

3. <u>Essay</u>

• Type an essay of 500 words or more describing your career aspirations, honors, awards, extracurricular activities, participation in the AHEPA/Church community, and the importance of your Hellenic connection.
